

This letter of articulation consists of an agreement between the JIBC (JIBC) and Canadian Police College (CPC) School of Public Safety and Security (SPSS).

Objective of the Agreement:

JIBC agrees to articulate, through this agreement, to allow students who successfully complete the CPC Program (EDP), advanced standing into the Graduate Certificate of Public Safety (GCPSL).

Transfer of Credit:

The following transfer credits will be granted:
