Purpose and Objectives

Through the use of annual returns on a \$13 million endowment provided by the Province of British Columbia, the % & Scholarship Society (“the Society”) manages a suite of international scholarship programs designed to assist students to participate in academic, cultural, language or experiential study programs outside of Canada and the United States. In delivering these programs, the Society hopes to encourage students who are intellectually curious and are interested in expanding their educational experiences while at the same time developing a globally literate citizenry and workforce for BC.

Scholarships of \$2,000 to \$5,000 are awarded on a competitive basis to students from all regions of BC who demonstrate a combination of strong academic achievement and community

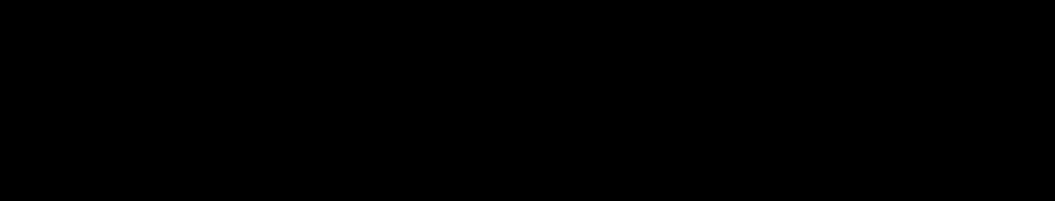
